Esta beca brinda apoyo educativo a los residentes de Delaware de entre 16 y 24 años de edad que sean hijos de miembros de las fuerzas armadas, oficiales de la policía estatal o empleados del sistema de carreteras estatales fallecidos o desaparecidos en servicio y cumplan requerimientos específicos de elegibilidad.

Comienzo del período de solicitud: 1 de dic. de 2025

Plazo: Viernes, 15 de mayo de 2026 a las 4:30 p.m.

Requisitos: Los solicitantes deben tener entre 16 y 24 años de edad y haber sido residentes de Delaware por al menos tres años consecutivos antes de la fecha de presentación de la solicitud. En el caso de que el padre del solicitante haya sido miembro de las fuerzas armadas, el padre debe haber sido residente de Delaware al momento en que falleciera o se lo declarara desaparecido en acción o prisionero de guerra. Los solicitantes deben ser hijos de una de las siguientes personas:

- Miembro de las fuerzas armadas cuyo fallecimiento se relacionara con el servicio militar; que esté o hubiese estado cautivo como prisionero de guerra; o que oficialmente se lo haya declarado desaparecido en acción.
- Oficial de policía estatal cuyo fallecimiento se relacionara con el servicio policial.
- Empleado del Departamento de Transporte del estado que realizara habitualmente actividades laborales relacionadas con el sistema de carreteras estatales cuyo fallecimiento estuviese relacionado con su empleo.

Solicitud: La solicitud se completa en línea a través del portal de ayuda económica para educación superior de Delaware. En el formulario de solicitud en línea se deberá incluir la información de preinscripción del estudiante para el ciclo 2026-2027 (establecimiento y especialización). La FAFSA de 2025-2026 del estudiante y otra información se solicitarán y recibirán durante el proceso de evaluación.

Asignación: Esta beca cubre las tarifas y los costos de las clases en una universidad pública de Delaware; una universidad privada de Delaware, si el programa de estudios no estuviera disponible en una universidad pública; o una institución en otro estado, si ningún establecimiento educativo de Delaware ofreciera el programa de estudios. Las becas se prorratean para los estudiantes que estudien en establecimientos que no sigan esta secuencia y pueden otorgarse por un máximo de cuatro años.

El Academic Common Market (ACM) es un acuerdo de ahorro en clases entre 15 estados del sur afiliados a la Junta de Educación Regional del Sur (Southern Regional Education Board). Los estudiantes que asisten a una **institución pública participante** pueden reunir los requisitos para acceder a un descuento en el costo de las clases si su programa universitario no está disponible en un establecimiento público de Delaware.

Requisitos para acceder al ACM:

- Haber sido residente de Delaware durante los últimos 12 meses o más al momento de la solicitud.
- El programa universitario del estudiante no debe estar disponible en la University of Delaware o Delaware State University.
- 3. Haber sido aceptado en un programa elegible de nivel universitario o de posgrado.

Nota: El ACM no incluye programas de primer diploma profesional, como farmacia, medicina, veterinaria, odontología, optometría, teología o derecho.

Aspectos para tener en cuenta:

Los programas que se ofrecen en el ACM son seleccionados por las universidades públicas participantes y están sujetos a modificaciones. Los estados y las universidades también pueden imponer restricciones para la participación en el ACM, como inscripción en programas universitarios o de posgrado únicamente; inscripción de tiempo completo; o la aprobación de un curso específico para ingresar al programa universitario.
